



City and Guilds level 3 in Close Protection Operations

Course Outline

Close Protection Officers or Bodyguards offer protection to a diverse clientele, ranging from the rich and famous, politicians, diplomats and even those placed in witness protection programmes. Bodyguards can be seen daily protecting their 'Principals' from assault, kidnapping, assassination, stalking, loss of confidential information or compromising positions, but more often the professional bodyguard is the 'grey man blending into the background close and ready to intervene should an incident threaten

The City & Guilds Level 3 in Close Protection Operations is a intensive training course (150 guided learning hours held over 16 days) and prepares the candidate for the challenging career of a bodyguard/close protection operative. Delivered in 14 core sessions with a separate element for tactical communications and conflict management, this course enables the successful candidate to apply for the security industry authority licence to work in the United Kingdom.

Target Audience

- Candidates with a serious interest in the security industry
- Experienced security operatives unlicensed bodyguards
- Ex-Military personnel, MoD resettlement referrals, police and prison officers

Course Objective

The programme is designed to provide the necessary skills and knowledge for candidates to undertake the role and responsibilities of the bodyguard/close protection operative. On completion of the course, the candidate will understand the importance of teamwork, enbus and debus drills, protective walking and vehicle formations, travel management, venue & residential security as well as other key security functions specific to close protection operations. On completion of the course and successfully passing the examination, the candidate will be awarded the internationally recognised City & Guilds Level 3 Certificate for Close Protection Operations which will allow them to apply for SIA licence currently required to work in the United Kingdom or for work with specific British contractors abroad.
